Parent Information

- Parent(s) 2017 Income Tax Return
 - IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040 EZ
 - W-2s
- Parent(s) marriage status (single, divorced, widowed, remarried)
- Parent(s) Month/Year of marriage, divorced, widowed, or remarried
- Parent(s) Date of Birth
- Parent(s) Social Security Number
- Parent(s) Current Investment Values (stocks, bonds, savings account, business value), if any.
- Parent(s) child support statements (if any)
- Parent(s) Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID
 - If your parent(s) have not established an FSA ID, one can be requested at www.fsaaid.ed.gov
 - An FSA ID is required to electronically sign the FAFSA.
 - Only one parent is required to sign the FAFSA, therefore one parent (your mother OR father) may request an FSA ID.
