 Close out status of the TGE 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Building Project, by Mr. Armando Martinez, M-5 Texas Enterprises, Contractor and Mr. George Lazaro, Fulcrum Consulting Services, Project Manager

Mr. Lazaro stated M-5, Mr. Armando Martinez has been doing a great job working with all his vendors and getting the affidavits of all bills paid. He has turned in to us a series of copies where he has done the necessary releases from everybody. Unfortunately there's a little discrepancy between the final retainage money that he is showing and of course against the records from the school, there's an \$800 difference between the two figures. We just got the last revision from Mr. Martinez this afternoon. There are three or four items that need to be taken care of that have come up since the last payment that was given to M-5 and that includes some adjustments to some doorknobs, small adjustments to the air conditioning system and then there's a sink that needs to be connected. We don't have the drain and we also don't have faucets connected to them so because of those small items, I recommend that we table any kind of action toward that until we officially work that out with your business manager and Mr. Martinez to balance out the funds because like I said its \$800 that we need to really get ironed out. It would also give Mr. Martinez the time to get his subs in to be able to coordinate the repairs on those items that are on warranty issues that need to be taken care of. Hopefully on the next meeting we can go ahead and have those documents ready and officially present it for recommendation to your superintendent so that she can go on and place it on your agenda.

Ms. Chavez stated what I need right now from you is an official document releasing contingencies and based on the review of the work that should have been implemented and has cleared at this point however I'm asking the board to also look at the items that are still pending and one of the areas that Mr. Lazaro discussed and proposed today is the preapproval and then also pending his review that all of that is implemented. In other words, the district is not going to release any funding until he is able to clear the contractor from all of the pending responsibility's and the district does not issue any payment to the contractor until we have a signed payment order from his office.

Mrs. De la Rosa stated so what your saying is that you don't want to table this. You want us to approve a contingence.

Ms. Chavez replied those are two options that we discussed today. You still have the review and the opportunity to ensure that all that work is done because no payment will be issued and approve it with the understanding that we will work with the project manager to certify that all the work pending has been completed.

Mr. Lazaro stated once I give that document to Ms. Chavez addressed to her then at that time the check will be issued to the contractor.
